1 No Matters Arising from Last Month's Minutes

2 Treasurers Report:

Dene produced her report prior to the meeting.

1. Balances are high at the moment. The majority of this is allocated to the track refurbishment.
2. Dene has now paid the majority of the cash held into the bank.
3. One invoice outstanding from Mansbridge for £1,000. This is due at the end of April.
4. Payments of £4,785.00 made on 3/4/23. All but £45 of this was for our affiliation fee and membership fees. £45 for a refund on overpayment of membership fees.
